FAQs

How do I check my application status?

- To check your online application status, you need to visit our student portal and login with your credentials.
- Under application you must click on academic admission status.

Can I hand deliver my application?

- SWG TVET College no longer accepts any hand delivered applications, only ONLINE applications.

Can a grade 12 student apply for NCV?

- Students with Matric/Grade 12 do not qualify for NCV programme, they can apply for REPORT 191 programmes.

What is a placement test?

- It is the test designed to evaluate an applicant's knowledge and proficiency in various programs offered in the college.
- The results of the test are used by the Campus Selection Committees to help advise prospective students on a suitable programme.

Who qualifies to study for report 191 (Nated) programmes?

- Students who have passed grade 12/NCV level 4 may be admitted into N4 Business and Utility Studies, subject to any other programme/faculty requirements.
- Students who have passed grade 12 with work experience may be admitted into N4 Engineering studies, subject to any other programme/faculty requirements.

Who qualifies to study for NCV programs?

- Prospective students should have an NQF Level 1, which is Grade 9, AET level 4, General Education and Training Certificate (GETC) and PLP results.

If my application is unsuccessful, can I apply for a different course?

- Use the student number received during your first application
- Click on the link for returning students
- Complete your application on the academic application link for the new course that you would like to apply for.
